Frequently Asked Questions - Campaign Volunteer Hours

Q: What is Survey Monkey?

A: Survey Monkey is a website that helps collect data in a quick and easy way. It can be filled out on phones, tablets, computers, etc.

Q: Does the link change every month?

A: Every person has the same link. The link will be the same each month so you can save the link to your phone, tablet or computer.

Q: What counts as volunteer hours?

A: Volunteer hours are hours spent helping campaigns. Qualifying activities include: attending rallies, phone banking, letters to the editor, Election Day operations, get out the vote, strike forces, door canvassing, volunteer training, volunteering for candidates, hosting events, staffing an office, stuffing envelopes and putting together yard signs. There is also an option for "Other" to specify if you'd like to request other time to be counted.

Q: Who submits campaign hours?

A: Every NFRW member! This is not to be done by state presidents or club presidents on behalf of a group. This is to be done by individuals.

Q: When and how often do I submit my hours?

A: Hours should be submitted on a monthly basis by no later than 5pm EST the 2nd day of the following month. (For example, hours for July are due August 2nd.) Submitting hours once a month is preferred in order to ensure members do not accidentally "double count" their hours. However, hours can also be submitted "in real time", which can mean once a day or once a week as members complete their volunteer activities. In this case, multiple submissions can be made during that month.

Q: How will I know if my hours are counted?

A: Upon completing the survey, a message will appear on your screen that says: "Thank you for completing our NFRW Campaign Survey!" By submitting hours, you will be eligible for prizes and awards.

Q: Why am I submitting my hours?

A: Campaign volunteer hours have always been a critical part of the NFRW's mission. We need to ensure all members hours are counted to show the strength of the organization.
