## **S**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ISRAEL

WHEREAS the modern nation of Israel was formed in 1947 by Jewish patriots, with the approval of the United Nations, in answer to a wide-spread attempted genocide of the Jewish people during WWII, a war which left dead 6 million Jews plus up to 12 million Christians; and

WHEREAS Israel was formed in a geographic area that has never contained an Arab or Palestinian state, an area with boundaries representative of the historical homeland of the Jewish people, to provide a Jewish state where its citizens could live safely, freely in peace, yet its Muslim neighbors have attempted to destroy it since 1948 when it was a mere 24 hours old; and

WHEREAS in 1967, the leader of Egypt with other nations amassed military assets on Israel's borders, publicly threatening to destroy her, Israel responded with a successful pre-emptive strike that drove back the aggressors; and

WHEREAS in 1978, Israel demonstrated her commitment to peace with her Islamic neighbors by giving back to Egypt the entire Sinai peninsula - the area gained in the 1967 war - along with its immense oil assets in exchange for peace; and

WHEREAS "Land for peace" is a policy Israel has always been willing to engage with the Palestinians, in return for simple recognition of Israel as a Jewish state with promises of peace from the Palestinians; and

WHEREAS the land mass of Israel, an area about the size of the US state of New Jersey, is surrounded by Muslim nations that stretch from the Atlantic Ocean to the Indian Ocean, many of whom continue to seek her destruction, either rhetorically or through arming the Palestinians; and

WHEREAS the modern nation of Israel respects human rights including the freedom of religion, protects all of its citizens regardless of their faith, including in its government elected representatives of many faiths - Christian, Muslim, Jewish; and

WHEREAS Israel recognizes the right of Palestinians to have their own state, yet instead of choosing peaceful independence, the Palestinians elected Hamas, a recognized terrorist organization; and

WHEREAS Hamas is wasting the public treasure of the Palestinians, is building dozens of multi-million-dollar tunnels that serve as combined armory-incursion points into Israel for terrorist purposes, is lobbing hundreds of missiles into Israel's neighborhoods, is retaining in its charter its overt goal to see Israel obliterated; and

WHEREAS Hamas flaunts human rights, engages in despicable attempts to shield its terrorist assets inside its own schools, hospitals, mosques, even hanging its small crying children on the walls of buildings being used as weapons caches, and

WHEREAS Islamic nations continue to train up their children to hate Israel in addition to the United States, promoting the destruction of both, even at the expense of their own peaceful, productive lives; and

WHEREAS much of the media coverage concerning Israel's attempts to remove these threats to her people is biased, highlighting the tragedies rather than fairly covering Israel's extreme efforts to protect innocent Palestinian life,

BE IT RESOLVED that the North Carolina Federation of Republican Women supports the right of Israel to live in peace, to take defensive measures she deems necessary to remove known threats to her people, so that Jewish, Christian and Muslim Israelis may remain safe and free.
