Upcoming NC Pro-life legislation

- A coalition of NC pro-life groups have drafted *The Heartbeat Act* which will save 86% of babies currently killed by abortion violence in North Carolina.
 - Right now the General Assembly leadership is deciding between the Heartbeat Act and a 13-week ban, which would only stop 13% of the babies being aborted.
 - Since the Dobbs decision in June, abortions have increased in North Carolina by 37%, reportedly the largest increase of any state in the nation.
 - The legislature is one vote short of a super-majority to override Cooper's veto. There are 3 pro-life Democrats who are likely to vote pro-life, so this is our best opportunity in decades.
 - We need your help now! Please contact your Republican legislators ASAP to ensure they know that we want to eradicate abortion, and the Heartbeat Act will make North Carolina a destination for life, not abortion.
